The Transportation Security Administration has just posted the following message to its public website.

The TSA has instructed passenger air carriers that they must screen at least 75 percent of cargo uplifted in the U.S. by May 1, 2010. The Implementing the Recommendations of the 9/11 Act of 2007 stipulated that the industry must have attained 50 percent by February 2009, and 100 percent by August 1, 2010. The airlines may provide comment on the pending intermediate requirement to reaching 100 percent as provided for by the Code of Federal Regulations
