Homeland Security Committee's majority staff has requested the Airforwards Association meet in person to share their thoughts and concerns on the recently issued TSA Interim Final Rule (IFR) for Certified Cargo Screening Program and the IAC Pilot Program. The meeting will take place the morning of Wednesday, October 7th.

Given the concerns over STA fees, pilot program funding and other issues, I believe this meeting will be extremely helpful in ensuring Congress compels TSA to keep the programs moving forward, and in a way that does not pose undue burdens on IAC pilot participants or their customers in CCSP.
